HELP US REPLACE THEIR SCHOOL: It was reported that more than 1,000 people in Haiti died as a result of Hurricane Matthew. However, we work in the southern mountains where there was no loss of life. In Mare Blanche <u>we lost a school building</u>. We need money to have it torn down and replaced by a new school.
