### A MEDICAL STRONGHOLD IS BLOCKING THE WAY TO HIS TREATMENT:

Little six-year old Davidson has a very rare birth defect in his groin area. We have been trying for more than one year to get the medical treatment he needs to correct the problem in hope that he will have a normal life.

The focus of our ministry is primarily Christian based education and evangelism. In the course of completing school physicals Davidson's parents requested help for him. Just like the good Samaritan on the Jericho road, along the way we have needed to pause and attend to other critical needs such as this child.

Correcting his condition requires treatment outside of Haiti. He has had presurgical exams and tests. However, a diagnosis and referral have stalled.

Please pray that doors are opened and that medical and financial re-

sources will be there when they do. God has already touched the hearts of Ed and Sue *Davidson* Irwin to step up and help. Mrs. Irwin's maiden name is also Davidson. Did God match Mrs. Irwin's name with this Haitian child?? Additional support will be needed in any case.

THEIR NEW SCHOOL IS UNDERWAY. The walls of the new school are going up in the background. Stone buildings seem to be most suited for several reasons. The remote area makes it near impossible to deliver other types of building materials. Rocks and sand are plentiful and help the economy when we purchase within the community. Deliveries of cement, rebar and other supplies are very costly and can only be delivered to within a 45-minutes walk to the construction site.
