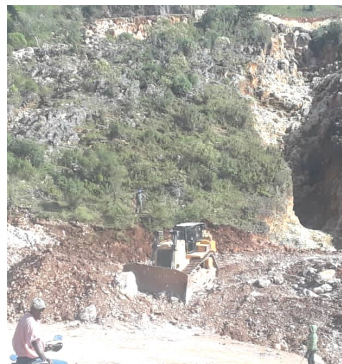

Now that the August hurricanes’ break in the road has been repaired by the Haitian government, Pastor Wisny Exima, was able to make several, still dangerous trips up the mountain in late January and early February to deliver a two-month supply of food to our kids. Now, the difficult manual task will begin to repair holes in the 1 1/2 to 2 hour trek remaining which has been destroying our rental trucks.

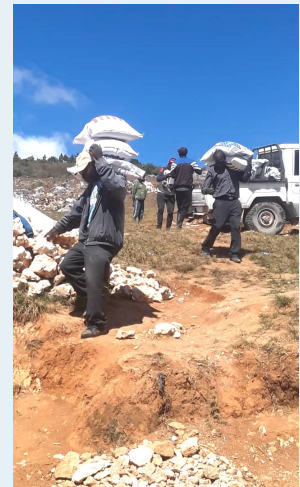


A Work Force Organized!
