## Struck With Blindness?

In 2 Kings 6:18 Elisha prayed that God would strike the enemy army with blindness. This led to protection and victory for Elisha and his servant.

Covered in prayer to make violent gangs blind to their activities, our Haitian oversight coordinator, Pastor Wisny Exima, two nurses, and another worker successfully made it through Matissant to deliver school food, supplies, uniforms, garden seeds, gasoline, a repaired generator, medicine, and medical supplies to our main location in the southern mountains at Marre Blanche.

Matissant is one of the strongholds where gangs have killed others trying to get through their road blocks.

Our seasoned nurse, Gernise Telsaint, and nurse, Mona Gervais conducted a medical clinic and served more than 160 children.

## Mountain Roads Always a Challenge

Not only are mountain roads challenging to maneuver, they are also very dangerous. Any effort to repair them is lost following the next storm. For this trip we had to make the following repairs to our rental truck: replace the rear differential, replace the bushings, pay for welding where needed, and replace two rear tires.

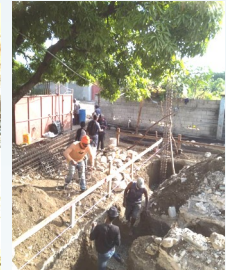
## Orphanage Foundation Work

## Join 80,000 Praying for Haiti!

Corporate prayer to our faithful God is our best weapon against the crisis in Haiti. This is an invitation for you to “#Join80,000Praying4Haiti. If we ask God to do things that we can easily accomplish we are pretending to work and ignoring his desire to show Himself strong in and through us and for the world to know that He is God and nothing is too hard for Him.

The country of Haiti is in ruins. The children and their parents live in fear and hunger. They are denied basic necessities and opportunities to pursue a better life. This oppression is not from outsiders, but homegrown gangs who have taken over.

But this invitation is about a faithful God who always saves a remnant. He is answering the prayers of a little orphanage housing 25 orphans living in the suburbs of the capital of Port-au-Prince. Their orphanage building was damaged during the 2010 earthquake and further damaged during the August 14, 2021 earthquake causing their facility to be unsafe. They needed a new building.

God has done a quick work through our ministry that has never be accomplished in such a short time in our 22 years of serving in Haiti. To tear down and replace the building will cost an estimated \$83,000.00. With much prayer and outstanding donations **God has brought in the full amount needed** to demolish and build a new 2,200 square foot facility. All additional funds will help provide furnishings for the orphanage, as well as, education, nutrition, and other services for children in Haiti.

Your prayers and the prayers of many are needed to ensure the safety of the workers and the children. There are great dangers of kidnappings, robberies, and murders. We need your prayers and thousands of others to build a wall of safety that will blind the enemies from what is happening at the “**God’s Work for the Poor Children of Haiti**” orphanage.

However, we cannot just pray for this one orphanage. The kids will never be safe until Haiti is much safer. Therefore, our ministry leaders have identified seven prayer needs for Haiti.

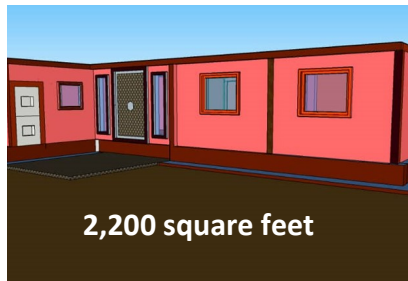
**Prayer Needs:** 1) **Marre Blanche, Haiti School** – students, parents, teachers, and staff well-being and success 2) **Orphanage building construction:** orphans, teachers and workers protection and safety 3) **Haitian government** – Strong Christian values: wisdom, integrity, and the people first 4) **Haitians as a people:** released from bondage/provided life essentials and future hope 5) **15 remaining hostages and all others kidnapped released/the ending of violence and deprivation** 6) **Gang members converted** through salvation in Christ and provided restored love for humanity 7) **Hope for Caribbean Kids, Inc. American and Haitian workers, as well as all missionaries and volunteers throughout Haiti** unhindered in the execution of God’s call and plan for their services

**Our goal is to register 80,000 people praying for Haiti** across the city, country and world. Join us and invite everyone you know. Only a mighty move of God can change their situation for the better.
